Dreams and Dream Interpretation: Guardian of Sleep

“And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh: and your son’s and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams.”

How often do we dream dreams and push them aside, not realising that often the Holy Spirit is speaking to our spirit?

We spend a third of our life on this earth asleep.

God spoke in both Old testament and New testament times to His prophets, to common every day people. Dreams provided divine guidance, foretold future events, led others away from danger and challenged the condition of people’s hearts.

This book endevous to teach some of the basic principals for dream interpretation.

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Introduction

The gift of interpreting dreams was one of the early manifestations of the prophetic gifting in my life. My wife, Tania, and I flowed in this gifting, but had little understanding of its significance.

In 1994, Tania and I attended a prophetic conference in Kansas City. John Paul Jackson taught on the ministry of interpreting dreams, which encouraged us to see this ministry as a valuable and often missing element of the prophetic voice. This changed our understanding and intensified both our desire and anointing in this area.

This awakening was followed by a period of ministry to the nations which resulted in our first book, *“Dreams and Dream Interpretation.”* Our desire was to reproduce in others, what we had been given by the Lord.

Knowing how difficult it was for us to find any information on this subject we felt prompted to notate the principles and methods that we were using so that others could mature in this gifting. The cry of my heart is to see people moving in this gifting, relying not on their intellect but on the anointing of the Holy Spirit.

This book is not to be read as a text book, with the symbols and methods being a finite source of interpretation and discernment. It must be read with the guidance and assistance of the Holy Spirit to bring to light the truth contained therein, rather than merely from the intellect and its faculties.

My prayer is that the Holy Spirit will anoint you to see with His eyes and hear with His ears.

Understanding Dreams

The language of dreams is complex. To understand the symbols and the insight they contain truly is a gift from God.

“But there is a God in heaven that revealeth secrets and maketh known to the king Nebuchadnezzar what shall be in the latter days. Thy dream, and the visions of thy head upon thy bed, are these...”

Daniel 2:28

No interpretation belongs to man but only to God.

“And Joseph answered Pharoah, saying, It is not in me: God shall give Pharoah an answer of peace.”

Genesis 41:16

God will reveal his secret and mysteries to His people by His spirit if they ask for wisdom.

“But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory.”

1 Corinthians 2:7

“But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit, for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.”

1 Corinthians 2:10

“If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.”

James 1:5

God often seals up the “thoughts (dreams) of a man’s head” so as to develop a seeking life in the person. You may be anointed to interpret dreams but sometimes God will seal up their meaning to cause you to yield yourself to other prophets or ministries.

He may even hide the meaning from the magicians or the mystics who usually are able to understand what He gives so that they must seek a prophet of God for the interpretation.

“And it came to pass in the morning that his spirit was troubled; and he sent and called for all the magicians of Egypt, and all the wise men thereof: and Pharoah told them his dream; but there was none that could interpret them unto Pharoah.”

Genesis 41:16

“Daniel answered in the presence of the king, and said, The secret which the king hath demanded can not the wise men, the astrologers, the magicians, the soothsayers, show unto the king...”

Daniel 2:27

The bible clearly states in 1 Corinthians 2:14 that the natural man can not know the things of God for they are spiritually discerned. So to understand dream interpretation we must bypass the soul (natural) man, which is the mind dominant man, and allow our spirit man to receive God’s intuitive thoughts. These can sometimes be given to us by angels.

“And he said, Behold, I will make thee know what shall be in the last end of the indignation; for at the time appointed the end shall be.”

Daniel 8:19

Many people make the mistake of thinking that there is a formula or symbols by which they can work out exactly what a dream means. This is a mistake because without the assistance of the Holy Spirit’s ability to reveal truth, the discernor is relying purely upon their own reasoning faculty, undoubtedly leading them to misinterpret what God is trying to communicate.

Dreams must be spiritually discerned. Symbols may assist the discernor in this process but not in exclusion of the Holy Spirit’s ability to bring enlightenment. As the interpreter yields to the Holy Spirit clarity is given to the dream and the intended message.

One of the most commonly asked questions is why does God speak to his people in riddles? Why not speak plainly, in a language that all can understand? Jesus provided the answer to this in Matthew 13:10-13.

“And the disciples came, and said unto him, why speakest thou unto them in parables? He answered and said unto them, Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries

of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given. For whosoever hath, to him shall be given, and he shall have more abundance; but whosoever hath not, from him shall be taken away even that he hath. Therefore speak I to them in parables: because they seeing see not: and hearing they hear not, neither do they understand.”

Jesus is saying that those who really wanted to know and to hear his voice would be able to understand, but those that were half hearted would not. It is my experience that those who are seeking with all their heart to understand gain the ability to hear God speak plainly and the gift of interpreting God’s riddles.

“And he said, Hear now my words: If there be a prophet among you, I the Lord will make myself known unto him in a vision, and will speak unto him in a dream. My servant Moses is not so, who is faithful in all mine house. With him will I speak mouth to mouth, even apparently, and not in dark speeches; and the similitude of the Lord shall he behold: wherefore then were ye not afraid to speak against my servant Moses?”

Numbers 12:6-8

My experience is that God speaks to men often in dreams to teach them to hear his voice, but the ultimate goal is for man to hear and see God plainly. It is important to note that in the book of Job 33:14 it says that God speaks three times to man before he gives him a dream. God is patient and he waits until we are asleep so that our reasoning factors are still, then he opens our spirit up and seals a dream there.

God’s preferred method of communicating to his people is through the three main faculties of conscience, intuition and communion. The dream language is a form of last resort by God to get our attention and communicate important messages.

Take Jesus for example. If God’s preferred method of communication were dreams, Jesus would have spent most of his life sleeping, when in reality it was the opposite. He maximised his ability to receive God’s instruction by his senses. (John 5:19-20)

None-the-less, dreams are still a valuable source of revelation, otherwise God would not have included them as a sign of the End Times outpouring of His Spirit. Dreams and interpretation are to be seen as the beginning stage in the development of the prophetic ministry. As the prophet matures dreams become more vivid and move from guidance and directional to an increase in revelatory understanding. Dreams about situations, places, problems, countries and the realms of the spirit tend to increase because the prophet has gained the understanding and wisdom to be able to correctly interpret the information God is giving him. This would explain why it is prophesied that “your old men will dream dreams” because they have the wisdom to interpret these.

Daniel is a great example of this. At the start of the Book of Daniel he was interpreting dreams. By the end of the book he is flowing in revelation knowledge.

In Jacob's dream when the angels were ascending and descending on the ladder the vision gave way to his voice. This is how it should be with us. As we receive anything from God it should make way for us to receive his voice and to have clear understanding. For this to be possible we must maintain a condition of receptivity and sensitivity.

Most of what people dream does not make sense. If they learn to still their mind while being focused on Jesus the Holy Spirit can and will give the dreamer the thoughts of the dream.

“Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ.”

2 Corinthians 10:5

The soul, or mind, will and emotions, must be brought to stillness, not being permitted to rationalise. This can be achieved by maintaining a fixed, locked, concentrated focus on Jesus that prohibits distraction or 'rabbit tracking.'

It is a dangerous practice to disregard the language of dreams. The book of Job contains several warnings against this.

“For God speaketh once, yea twice, and man perceiveth it not. In a dream, in a vision of the night, when deep sleep falleth upon me, in slumberings upon the bed; Then He openeth the ears of men, and sealeth their instruction. That He may withdraw man from his purpose, and hide pride from man. He keepeth back his soul from the pit and his life from perishing by the sword. He is chastened also with pain upon his bed, and the multitude of his bones with strong pain: So that his life abhorreth bread, and his soul dainty meat. His flesh is consumed away, that it can not be seen: and his bones that were not seen stick out. Yea, his soul draweth near unto the grave, and his life to the destroyers.”

Job 33:14 -22

The Lord will allow sickness to come and the desire for food to be taken away if we disregard our dreams. To me this is a real warning that dreams are important and should not be taken too lightly. It would be far more beneficial for the individual to hear the voice of the Lord during the day than in a dream where he is being chastened.

“Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless, afterward it yieldeth the

peaceable fruits of righteousness unto them who are exercised thereby.”

Hebrews 12:11

This passage says that we are being exercised by this, but what is being exercised? It is our spiritual senses that he wants trained and exercised!

“But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.”

Hebrews 5:14

Through our being chastened, we will learn to allow our conscience and our intuition faculty to be sensitive to the promptings of the Holy Spirit. The more sensitive we become the less we will be chastened.

When God speaks to the people of the world in dreams it is usually God’s last warning before chastisement or judgement. Sometimes, however, the individual may have a genuine gift from God that is not in union with the Holy Spirit because the gifts and calling are without repentance (Romans 11:29).

The Old Testament has vivid examples of dreams that are last warnings from God. The Pharaoh King of Egypt and King Nebuchadnezzar were both visited with dreams of pending doom.

The most common asked question regarding the unbeliever and dreams is, “Do you use the same method of interpreting for the unbeliever as you do for the believer?” My answer is yes. It is the same anointing. The symbols that are in the bible work for both categories. An unbeliever’s dreams are often related to their soulish desires and may expose their hearts or thinking to the interpreter. In this way it may be a valuable insight for the believer in gaining understanding of the unbeliever. It would be foolish to think that the unbeliever can not have their dreams interpreted by the same manner as the believer. The gifts and callings of God are for the Church and not for the world but if the world desires to understand then let them come and inquire of the Lord. Then there is opportunity for him to speak through the mouth of his prophets.

It is a matter of wisdom. The bible says not to cast your pearls before swine and let them trample them underfoot. This is why you do not see Christians in the market place in dream booths interpreting dreams like the occult do. As the church matures, and reaches out into the world, the Lord Jesus will unlock the mysteries of people’s dreams by the Holy Spirit.

Discerning the Origin

This is one of the most important aspects of dream interpretation. It is one thing to understand the message of the dream, but if you do not know the source of the message you can interpret it correctly but still be misled.

This misleading I would term a deception. A definition of deception, in this context, is evil spirits influencing our hearts and minds keeping us from the truth and leading us into unperceived error of judgment and understanding.

By unperceived error I refer to the heart as being **“deceitfully wicked.”** (Jeremiah 17:9-10) No man can know the magnitude of their self deception, nor their potential to be deceived. Just because you are a blood bought believer does not guarantee you will be kept from deception. (Revelations 12:9 and Matthew 24:4-5)

Paul said to the Church at Corinth, **“Let no man deceive himself.”** (1 Corinthians 3:18) He would not have said this unless there was a potential for self deception. (James 1:22, 1 Corinthians 8:13)

The realms of self deception are notated in James 1:14-16 as being:

“But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin when it is finished, bringeth forth death. Do not err, my beloved brethren.”

If there is any unsanctified part within the heart, or if the heart dislikes truth for any reason, consciously or unconsciously, the heart will be susceptible to deception in varying degrees.

“Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.”

Proverbs 4:23

“Search me oh God and know my heart and try me and know my thoughts and see if there be any wicked way in me.”

Psalms 139:23-24

“And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men love darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For everyone that doeth evil hateth the light, neither come to the light, lest his deeds should be reprov'd. But he that doeth truth cometh to the light,

that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.”

John 3:19-21

“But if our gospel be hid it is hid to them that are lost: in whom the God of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.”

2 Corinthians 4:3-4

“But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same veil untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which veil is done away in Christ but even unto this day, when Moses is read the veil is upon their hearts. Nevertheless when it shall turn to the Lord the veil shall be taken away.”

2 Corinthians 3:14-16

The heart of the individual determines the direction the spirit and soul will take. It can make a person believe that a lie is truth, and vice versa. That is why it is necessary to have the gift of distinguishing of spirits.

The gift of distinguishing of spirits, from the Holy Spirit, brings to man revelation knowledge (intuitive intelligence), the ability to detect, identify, interpret, apprehend, comprehend, perceive, discover and understand spirit entities. These entities are behind every thought, feeling, attitude, motive, action, reaction and silence.

From scripture we see that there are nine origins by which we receive information from the realm of the spirit. These are:

1. Flesh - **Galatians 5:17**
2. Soul (mind) - **Luke 5:21-22**
3. Spirit - **1 Corinthians 2:11**
4. Just men made perfect - **Hebrews 12:1**
5. Angels - **Daniel 10:9-15**
6. Jesus - **Hebrews 1:2**
7. Holy Spirit - **Acts 13:2**
8. The Father - **Mark 9:7**
9. Devils - **Luke 4:5**

Due to the diversity of means by which we can receive information it is imperative that we have the gift of distinguishing of spirits in operation to ensure that we are not misled. Further, we should submit ourselves to other prophets to confirm our own understandings. This can not be attained by reasoning or intellectual ability but must be an operation of the Holy Spirit. The bible says in **1 Timothy 5:19, Matthew 8:16** and

2 Corinthians 13:1, in the mouth of two or three witnesses that every truth is established.

Many make the error of asking for discernment but are impatient and will not wait for a more clear word. They run and they tell everybody, sometimes to their own detriment, when God's timing is always perfect. If we want to really have a clear word from God we must be willing to submit ourselves to others discernment and to be patient.

In **Galatians 2:1-14** and **Acts 15:1-32** we see that Paul was willing to submit the revelation that God had given him to the Elders and Apostles at Antioch and then at Jerusalem.

An example of this from my own life is when I had a dream about a minister. I said in my heart, when I meet this person I will deliver this dream to them. I did not see the person for two years. I told them the dream and it was absolutely accurate for what was happening in their life at that time. If I had rushed around trying to locate them and tell them when I had the dream it would have missed God's timing and may have resulted in discouragement for either myself or the minister.

This is not true in every case but is an example of how I personally deal with dreams that are for other people. In each situation you need to seek the Lord's timing.

The difference between natural discernment, and the distinguishing of spirits, is that natural discernment uses the reasoning faculties of the soul. Distinguishing of spirits, a gift of the Holy Ghost, in union with your spirit, always leads to a burden for prayer. Natural discernment has the potential to bring division to the body whereas the distinguishing of spirits will bring unity.

How Do I Interpret?

Interpretation of dreams is a combination of two things - the use of symbols and the anointing of God. Symbols are used as keys but it is the anointing that brings the true interpretation.

“And he informed me and talked with me and said, Oh Daniel, I now come forth to give thee skill and understanding. At the beginning of thy supplications the commandment came forth and I am come to show thee; for thou are greatly beloved: therefore understand the matter, and consider the vision.”

Daniel 9:22-23

This is how I interpret dreams. Firstly, I listen to the dream with my natural ears, but inwardly I am focussed on Jesus. I take all my thoughts captive, not allowing my mind to think. (2 Corinthians 10:5)

“Then said he unto me, Fear not, Daniel: For from the first day that thou did set thou heart to understand, and to chasten thyself before thy God thy words were heard and I am come for thy words.”

Daniel 10:12

“But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory even as by the Spirit of the Lord.”

2 Corinthians 3:18

“For God who commanded the light to shine out of the darkness has shined in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.”

2 Corinthians 4:6

As I do this, the Holy Spirit places intuitive thoughts in my mind. I may have some idea of what the dream means using symbols, but I choose to push these ideas aside to hear the Holy Spirit's interpretation. As the person shares the dream I visualise it upon the screen of my imagination. As I am doing this, the Holy Spirit's voice will start to speak to me.

Sight produces hearing, that is why Habakkuk the prophet said:

“I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and I will watch to see what He will say unto me, and what I shall answer when I am reproved.”

Habakkuk 2:1

If I am not one hundred percent focussed, or I am impatient and do not wait for all of the interpretation, I may bring a part truth and will get a caution in my spirit. I call this the ‘inner witness.’ If the interpretation is wrong, I get a sensation like a knife jab. If the interpretation has only part truth I experience an uncomfortable sensation. If you would like to experience this sensation, lace your fingers together and swap your thumbs over and you will begin to feel uncomfortable. Another example of this feeling is like when you walk into a room where two people have been arguing. You intuitively know that something is wrong because you feel uncomfortable. This uncomfortable feeling will increase and decrease depending upon the degree of error or truth. If you feel this sensation, withdraw what you have spoken and wait a bit longer to hear what the Holy Spirit will say. Sometimes you will need to wait on God for a long period before receiving the full interpretation. Daniel waited for one hour. Eventually you will be able to discern between what is right and wrong before speaking. Your discernment increases with your maturity in the gifting.

To be successful in dream interpretation it is essential to learn the art of stilling the natural senses - mind, emotions, will - and tuning into the voice of the Holy Spirit through your spiritual faculties. As you achieve success in this, your accuracy will increase. As the ‘soul man’ is brought into inactivity, the ‘spirit man’ will begin to function.

“Casting down imagination, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ.”

2 Corinthians 10:5

It has taken me years of practice, interpreting hundreds of dreams, to develop this gifting. It is by reason of use that our senses are trained. I exhort you to be keen to practise, and in so doing gain skill. Start by interpreting your own dreams so that you can learn to wait upon God and the Holy Spirit. Eventually you will be able to interpret other’s dreams as well.

Guardian of Sleep

There are three main functions of the human spirit - conscience, communion and intuition. This chapter will focus on the function of conscience, which I consider to be the "*Guardian of Sleep*." Understanding the functions of the human spirit is important when trying to comprehend the thoughts of the night. We must learn to discern between the body, the soul and the spirit, and to be able to divide the soul from the spirit, before we will be able to interpret dreams and visions correctly.

Conscience, the guardian of sleep, is the centre of conviction, either commending or condemning every thought, word or deed. It is considered to be the guardian of sleep because it will not allow you to sin and remain ignorant. Nor will it allow you to simply go to sleep and forget that you have sinned. It will expose your heart through your dreams, guarding your spirit, soul and body from corruption.

"Therefore I will not refrain my mouth. I will speak in the anguish of my spirit. I will complain in the bitterness of my soul. Am I a sea or a whale that Thou hast set a watch over me? When I say my bed shall comfort me, my couch shall ease my complaint then Thou scarest me with dreams and terrifieth me through visions so that my soul chooses stranglings and death rather than my life. I loathe it. I would not live always. Let me alone for my days are vanity. What is man that Thou should magnify him and Thou should set thine heart upon him and that Thou should visit him every morning and try him every moment? How long will Thou not depart from me nor let me alone until I swallow down my spittle? I have sinned. What shall I do unto Thee oh Thou the preserver of men? Why has Thou set me a mark against Thee so I am a burden to myself?"

Job 7:11-20

When you sin, your conscience causes you to carry a burden of conviction. This burden only lifts through repentance or by a seared conscience, which is gained through continued sin and lack of repentance. The conscience can only be washed clean through the blood of Jesus. Job thought he could go to bed with a strong emotion of unforgiveness and that his sleep would ease his complaint. (Job 7:13) He was wrong. Instead of finding relief he was terrified by nightmares. The word "scarest me" (Job 7:14) means "to prostrate hence to break down either by violence or by confusion and fear, to abolish, to affright, to be made afraid, amazed, beat down, discouraged, caused to dismay, scared, terrify." This is the best example of conscience in the bible.

Violent dreams and nightmares can be an outworking of conscience or demonic attack. If a person is suffering from nightmares or violent dreams they should examine themselves to see if it is an issue of sin or if they are under demonic influence. I believe that the bible says, "Don't let the sun go down on your wrath" for this very reason, because if you do it will interfere with your night season.

5 Dream Categories

Sometimes our dreams are made easier to understand by loosely categorising them. The following categories are to be used as a guide when interpreting and may assist you to stimulate the anointing for interpretation.

Open Doors or Windows:

When you have a dream about an open door it is usually your bedroom door. This represents your place of rest. If the door is closed, spirits come through the door into your bedroom. You know that they are demons. You know that they are spirits and they are interrupting your rest. The interpretation of this dream is that there is an open door in your bloodline. It may have been closed but it has not been cut off. A door may be closed, but you can still gain access through it by opening it. If the door is to your house (the house represents you) and you can tell that there is someone there but you can not see them, this means there is something in the bloodline that needs to be cut off. There is a spirit that is seeking to gain access into your life.

The most common times for these kinds of dreams to occur is at significant points in your life - a marriage, a pregnancy, a birth, a significant age milestone. For example, when I married my wife, she broke out in boils. When she gave birth to my first child she broke out in boils again. We knew that we needed to cut off anything in the bloodline that was seeking entrance. When we prayed the boils ceased. Spirits wait because they know exactly where they have the right to gain access to your life. At a particular place and a particular time they are permitted to seek access. When diseases come up at significant times this may be a sign that spirits are seeking access.

Drugs:

A dream that you are smoking drugs or cigarettes may be interpreted to mean that you are under the influence of something you are listening to, watching or allowing into your life that has a delusion in it. For example, I was discussing doctrine with my Pastor in the morning. That night I dreamt we were at a Rolling Stones concert and there was marijuana smoke everywhere around us. The Lord told me to be careful, as what we were discussing was full of delusion. Where you are smoking cigarettes, this represents a mild delusion.

I deliberately keep books in my library that are full of delusions for the purpose of training prophetic people to discern the good from the bad. On the surface these books may seem okay, but when you discern you see the delusion in them. It is good training to read these books and to see them for what they are. One such book., "*The Keys to the Kingdom*," I gave to a Pastor I was ministering to in Tasmania. I asked him to read it. He read it and that night he dreamed that he was in a truck smoking marijuana. He came to me and asked what I had done to him. I explained to him that the material within that book was full of delusion.

Dream Symbols and Their Meanings

With caution I include these symbols and their meanings, knowing that people use them as a dictionary rather than the reference they are intended to be. Please consider them to be the water that primes the pump, rather than the water that is being drawn up from the well. They will aid the interpreter to begin to flow with the anointing but should not be confused for the anointing. The symbols presented have either been given to me by direct revelation or have been taught to me by other prophets.

Shapes and Numbers:

It sometimes happens that circles, squares or triangles occur in dreams and visions. Many people are reluctant to speak about them, because of fear that the visions may be demonic and come from the Devil.

- Circle - A circle can have various meanings. It has no beginning and no end and can also speak of God. The number one is associated with the circle and symbolises being one in Christ.
- Triangle - Speaks of harmony and unity (1 John 5:7-8). Black triangle might mean confusion or discord.

Vehicles:

- Smaller Vehicles - Push Bike, Motor Bike (Personal Ministry)
- Bus - Larger Ministry
- Boats - Corporate Ministry
- Jumbo Jets - Big Ministries

Instruments:

- Knives - Attacks of the enemy
- Guns - Spiritual power
- Boomerang - The word not returning void

Nature:

- Fire - Purification, attack
- River, Water, Lakes - People
- Trees - Leaders, Healing of Nations
- Crops - Harvest. Also the length of time it takes for a prophetic word to come to pass. (eg. Corn - 10 months)
- Mountains - Churches, movements. Snow capped is evil.
- Winds, tornadoes - Violent wind of Holy Spirit. Overturning tables.

Clothing:

- Clothing - Tells you where you are at - geographical.

Animals:

- Hornets - Demonic, not occultic, harassment, same with bees.
- Spiders - Occultic activity.
- Cow, Oxen - Laborious change, arduous process.
- Horses - Power.
- Bulls - Anger.
- Python - An overpowering deception. Colour is important. Uses its size and power to overpower its prey and make it completely passive.
- Snakes - A long tail (Falsehood, people talking about you).
- Cockroach - Unclean, lives under floorboards, flees from light (run to food preparation places.)
- Crocodiles - Looks to be deep things of God, deep water, but really it is about to devour you. Spirit of religion that leads to death.
- Frogs - (Revelations 16:13) According to this scripture, a frog indicates an unclean spirit that often occurs when people are being misled or deceived on the basis of false prophecies. The colour indicates the origin of the false prophecies and the way in which this deception takes place.
- Roosters - (Matthew 26:34) If you dream or have a vision about a rooster it is possible you are in contact with a person who is not trustworthy, but used in good application in power of one, a new day has begun.
- Pigs - (2 Peter 2:22) But it has happened to them according to the true proverb. A dog returns to his vomit, and a sow, having washed, to her wallowing in the mire. A pig speaks of a backsliding spirit.
- Dogs - A brown dog speaks of uncleanness and sexual sins. Savage Dogs (Revelations 22:15) speaks of aggressiveness and destruction toward precious spiritual truths, and gentiles.
- Elephant - An elephant is not mentioned in the word of God. The elephant nature however, is to dominate and manipulate. It is important to keep in mind that dreams and visions are given to us so that we may be more effective in ministry.
