The Assyrian records put Ahab's last year as coinciding with the 6th of Shalmanezar III. .§~ Jehoiachin's captivity is dated according to the 30th year of a Jubilee cycle (from the Jordan crossing). We know by the Assyrian Calendar that this took place in the middle of the 17th Jubilee Cycle. Ezekiel 1:1,2 allows us to pinpoint the year within the Jubilee Cycle, making our chronology very accurate.

H1storians also tell us that Jehoiachin was deported to Babylon in 597 BC, which allows us to link BC years with years from Adam. This verifies the link we made from the solar eclipse in 763 BC (Assyrian calendar) and the last year of king Ahab 90 years prior in 853 BC.

Ptolemy records a lunar eclipse in the 20th year of Darius I and another in his 31st year. Computers now show these occurred Nov. 19, 502 BC and April 25, 491 BC. Unce we have pinpointed the reign of Darius 1, and knowing he ruled 36 years (521-486), we then know his successor, Xerxes I ruled 21 years from 485-465 BC. His successor in turn, Artaxerxes 1, ruled 41 years from 464-424 BC. His 7th year was 459-457 BC. Ezra's says the decree came in the spring, at the beginning of his 7th year, 458 BC. 490 years later is the spring of 33 AD, when Jesus was crucified. Page - 12-

I"xplanation: God "takes account of His servants" (Mt. 18:23) after forgiving 70 x 7 (490) times (Mt. 18:22). Once a year on Day of Atonement, Israel was forgiven and all sin removed. But after 490 years, and having forgiven 490 times, God reckons the account to see if they are worthy to receive an extended period of Grace. An extension is granted only if the sinner forgives his neighbor of their sins (debts). Note the parable of Mt. 18:23-35), which explains Peter's question about how often to forgive his brother.

For those in rebellion against God, their "grace period" is shortened by 76 years to just 414 years, at which time God reckons their account and brings judgment, unless they repent or do that which was required of them. In the case of the ground, it did not bring forth the righteousness required, so the flood came in 4 x 414 years. Four is the number of the earth.

Israel in sin, does not bring forth the fruits of the Kingdom. So after 42 years, God "sells" them to Babylon for nonpayment of debt (sin) by the law of Exodus 22:3.

Thus, Israel must work off its debt by servitude to Babylon. Babylon, in turn, assumes the debt note to bring forth the fruits of the Kingdom. Babylon, too, is incapable of paying the debt, so comes under the Curse of the Law. Consequently, they fall in precisely 2 x 414 years.

1. Abram went to Canaan at the age of 55 (Jasher 13:5,9). The story in Gen. 12 was actually his 2nd trip after returning to Haran for a 5-year visit with his father. Jacob also went to Haran for 20 years (Gen. 31:38). The birthright was thus off the land for a total of 25 years. The birthright was in Canaan 210 years.

480 years after Exodus is the 4th yr. of Solomon (I Ki. 6:1). Thus, the 40th yr. of Solomon, when he died and the Kingdom split, was the year 2964. The Assyrian Calendar provides us with the date of the fall of Samaria as 721 BC.

The revolt of Israel was over taxation without proper representation. The same occurred with the American revolt from Britain (House of David).

Explanation: The significance of 390 is that it is a factor of 39, the number of weakness or infirmity. Israel as a nation was "weak" while they had no true King. On one level, David was the first anointed CHAw 28 King of Israel and resolved the problem. on another level, Othniel began the cycle of Judges until God would lay the Foundation-Jesus. The building process of the Temple would take 10 years from that time.
